I live in the United States, in Illinois, in a County called DeKalb. The company that put these things up has put up more than 9000 in the United States alone. Canada has thousands of them put up by various companies. This is a world wind phenomenon.

And, it has to stop.

Do all you can to fight it. The world wide web is loaded with information about this. Show it to your people.

Japan is about to do a detailed 4 year study on the sound effects of turbines.

There is a worldwide Noise symposium just for turbines.

There is a European Platform against them, and a North America Platform against them.
